Continue to host our annual gala fundraisers: Holiday in Smoke Rise Craft Show, Low Country Boil summer party, and Casino Night and Silent Auction at Smoke Rise Country Club.

Solicit donations and in kind gifts from area businesses and individual donors. Use our wide networking experience to demonstrate how helping at a local level is beneficial to businesses and the community. Explore grant possibilities and large corporate giving programs.

In August of 2010 the Foundation took over the SR After School Day program from the school system. We have increased enrollment, provided a greater level of educational programs and upgraded the programs resources. Since the program uses the play area a portion of the profits from the program will go towards our play area and its ongoing maintenance.

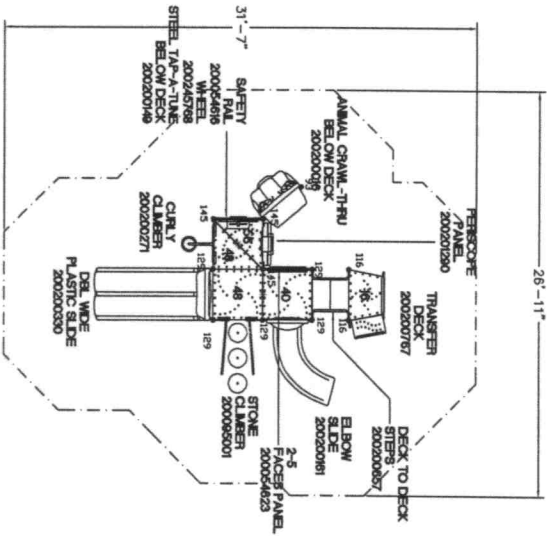

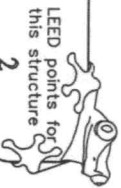
